WHAT IS HAPPENING AT SCHOOL:

- **SATURDAY 14TH MAY 10h00 – 12h30: Open Day, Soccer day & Entrepreneurs day:** Learners from Grade R up will play a match and the High School learners will play against an invitation team. At the same time we will be hosting our Annual Entrepreneurs day. The Grade 7 - 9 learners will host a variety of stalls as part of their EMS curriculum and attendance is compulsory for all learners in these grades. More information regarding Entrepreneurs day will be sent home closer to the time. The school will also be open for viewing by prospective parents for 2017.
- **FOUNDATION PHASE: Incremental implementation of an African language (IIAL): additional teaching time for grade 1 and 2 and the introduction of Sesotho:** As published in the Government Gazette No 39406, all schools are required to introduce a third language at grade 1 level in 2016. To allow for the extra teaching time required, all schools have been instructed to increase the school week for grades 1 and 2 by 1 hour. To comply with this, we have carefully considered our staff complement and we will be offering Sesotho from the second term to our grade 1 learners. **Grades 1 and 2 will finish school at 13:40 (instead of 13:10) on Tuesdays and Wednesdays from the start of the second term.** Grade 1 and 2 will continue to finish at 13:10 on Mondays, Thursdays and Fridays. We are looking forward to implementing this new policy as a way of encouraging communication in our country. Please inform transport operators and those who fetch learners about the change in school times.

All learners from grade 1 – 11 are encouraged to be part of an extramural activity.

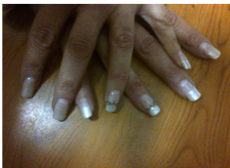
