



OUR BACKGROUND

Jubilee Christian School was started in 1995 by a steering committee consisting of families that were concerned about the education their children were receiving and wanted to start a school that was truly Christian in character and based on Biblical principles. Jubilee opened its doors to seven pupils in January 1995 and the numbers grew to 12 in the same year. At present Jubilee has in excess of 140 pupils.

Jubilee is a registered with the Gauteng Department of Education, and follows the National Curriculum of the Department of Education (CAPS). Matriculants write external exams set by the IEB (Independent Examination Board). Jubilee Christian School is a registered exam centre.

OUR VISION

The aim of Jubilee Christian School is to provide the children of Christian parents with an education that glorifies God in all aspects. The subjects are taught in such a way that teachers and pupils alike never lose sight of the fact that all knowledge is revealed by God, because He is the Creator of all things.

Compulsory subjects are English, Afrikaans, Life Orientation and Maths core or Mathematical Literacy.

May include Cricket, Soccer, Netball, Squash and Athletics

Community work:

Collections for and visits to the community such as: soup kitchens; AIDS homes; rehabilitation centres; senior citizens and orphanages.

ADMISSION AND REGISTRATION

CONDITIONS FOR REGISTRATION:

In order to apply for registration at Jubilee Christian School, at least one parent or the guardian of the learner must have a profession of faith in the Lord Jesus Christ and actively worship at a bible believing, Christian Church.

REGISTRATION PROCEDURE

1. A completed application form must be submitted to the school together with the following:
 - Parents'/Guardians' ID documents
 - The latest Water and Electricity account, or proof of residence
 - Latest salary advice/payslip **OR** letter of employment and bank statements. If self-employed 3 months bank statements.
 - Copy of the child's latest school report (not applicable for gr R and 1)
 - The child's birth certificate.
 - A letter of commendation from your pastor/minister.
2. Once the above documents have been received a placement test will be arranged for the prospective learner. (R150.00 fee in cash to be paid on the day of testing) School readiness testing for grade one learners will be arranged for later in the year.
3. Learners who do not pass this entrance exam will not be accepted.
4. Successful learners and parents will then be interviewed by our principal and governing body members.
5. Should your application be successful you will be invoiced a non-refundable registration fee, which is to be paid by the last day of the month of acceptance.
6. School policy and rules must be read and understood by parents and child.
7. Please arrange the transfer card from your child's previous school.
8. Copies of any professional report e.g. occupational therapy, IQ evaluation, speech therapy (if applicable).
