STATEMENT OF FAITH

We agree with the Statement of Faith as set out by the Association of Christian Schools, which states:

His personal return in power and glory (*Acts 1:11; Revelation 19:11*).

SCHOOL FEES

1. **Entrance Test / School readiness Fee:** R150.00 (*To be paid in cash on the day of testing*)
2. **Registration Fee:** R2500.00 (*per family, non-refundable*) **Please take note that registration fee will only be R1000 during Oct, Nov, Dec 2018**

4. **After care:** Is run by one of our teachers, but as a private concern; for more information you can contact the school.

5. **Other Expenses:**

Books: Parents have to pay for all books as well as stationery. A stationery and text book list is given to all learners. It is compulsory that each learner has his/her own text books at the start of the school year.

Travel and Compulsory outing expenses: parents will be required to pay for outings, camps etc.

OUR BACK GROUND

Jubilee Christian School was started in 1995 by a steering committee consisting of families that were concerned about the education their children were receiving and wanted to start a school that was truly Christian in character and based on Biblical principles. Jubilee opened its doors to seven pupils in January 1995 and the numbers grew to 12 in the same year. At present Jubilee has in excess of 100 pupils.

The school is registered with the Gauteng Department of Education and follows the National Curriculum of the Department of Education. Matriculants write external exams set by the IEB (Independent Examination Board). Jubilee Christian School is a registered exam centre.

SCHOOL GOVERNING BODY

The school is governed by a Governing Body who has financial responsibility for the school, staff and school property.

TEACHING

The curriculum planning is governed by the following:

- Christian principles instilled in all learning areas
- Providing a content rich curriculum
- Developing skills as outcomes of learning
- Developing an ethic of hard work
- Preparing learners so that they can achieve their potential
- Ensuring that learners develop spiritual, academic and moral strength

Choice Subjects: As a reminder each learner must do 7 subjects:

At the end of grade 9 learners select 3 choice subjects; in 2017 the subject groups are as follows (i.e. learners choose 1 subject from each group):

1. Business Studies
2. History **OR** Physical Science
3. Life Science **OR** Accountancy **OR** Visual Art

Compulsory subjects are English, Afrikaans, Life Orientation and Maths core or Mathematics Literacy.

A mark of 50% or more must be obtained for mathematics in grade 9, if a learner wishes to continue with Maths core, learners have to do Maths core in order to do Physical science and accountancy.

EXTRA MURALS AND CULTURAL ACTIVITIES

Cultural Activities:

May include Praise and Worship, Drama, Debating, Public Speaking and Chess

Sport:

Includes Cricket, soccer, squash and athletics, cheer leading

Community work:

Collections for and visits to the community such as: soup kitchens; AIDS homes; rehabilitation centres; senior citizens and orphanages.

Boys: Navy school long pants (Changing to grey by the beginning of 2019)

ADMISSION AND REGISTRATION

CONDITIONS FOR REGISTRATION:

In order to apply for registration at Jubilee Christian School, at least one parent or the guardian of the learner must have a profession of faith in the Lord Jesus Christ and actively worship at a Bible believing, Christian Church.

REGISTRATION PROCEDURE

A completed application form must be submitted to the school together with the following:

1. Parents'/Guardians' ID documents
2. A proof of residence no older than 3 months
3. Proof of income - Latest salary advice/payslip or 3 months bank statements of the person/s who will be paying the fees. If self-employed please provide 3 months bank statements.
4. Financial clearance certificate completed by the child's current school.
5. Copy of the child's latest school report (not relevant for Gr R and 1)
6. The child's birth certificate.
7. A letter of commendation from your pastor/minister – please refer to our statement of faith on page (If you do not attend a church, kindly include a letter advising the reason for this and the reason you would like your child to be educated at a Christian school.)
8. Results of eye screening test, no older than 6 months.
9. Results of auditory screening test (hearing), no older than 6 months.
10. Clinic/Immunisation card (foundation phase only)
11. 2. Once the above documents have been received an entrance test will be arranged for the prospective learner. (R150.00 fee in cash to be paid on the day of testing.)
12. Learners who do not pass this entrance exam will not be accepted.
13. Successful learners and parents will then be interviewed by our principal and governing body members.
14. Should your application be successful you will be invoiced a non-refundable registration fee, which is to be paid by the last day of the month of acceptance.
15. School policy and rules must be read and understood by parents and child.
16. Please arrange the transfer card from your child's previous school.
17. Copies of any professional report e.g. occupational therapy, IQ evaluation, speech therapy (if applicable).
